HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT:

In the year 1990 Degree Courses were introduced in G. L. Choudhury College under Gauhati University. The Pass Course, Political Science, under Gauhati University was introduced in 1990 and the Major Course was introduced in the academic session 1997-98 as per G.B. Resolution No.03 of the G.B. Meeting held on 29-06-1997.

The Department of Political Science got BA1stYear permission from GU on 24-04-1991 and BA 2nd year permission on 13-08-1994. The Department got BA part 1 concurrence On 03-04-1995. The Department had the opportunity to get TDC part 1 Affiliation on 04-01-1997, TDC part-II Affiliation on 24-10-1998, part II Affiliation on 03-03-2000 and permanent Affiliation on 31-08-2009 from GU.

The Department starts Major Course from the academic session 2003-04. Accordingly it got Major permission on 28-02-2003, TDC part-I Govt. Concurrence on 06-12-2008, TDC part-II Permission and TDC part-I Affiliation on 30-04-2010, TDC part-II Affiliation on 28-07-2010.

At the very beginning the Department was managed by Dr. Ramendra Kumar Das as an honorary part time Lecturer. On 30-08-1990 Abu Saleh Md. Mosa appointed as Lecturer in the Department, but he left the College on 30-09-1991. On account of his departure Mr. Prem Sagar Prasad was appointed as Lecturer in the Department on 19-08-1991 and he left the College on 07-06-1999. Babar Ali was appointed as Lecturer in the Department on 07-10-1991, but he left the College on 28-12-1991. On 03-08-1992 Subhash Sarma joined as Lecturer in the Department, but he left the College w.e.f., 09-09-1992. On 02-08-1999 Naba Sarma joined as Lecturer, but on 15-11-1999 he left the College. Similarly, Jadab Basumatary worked in the Department and on 30-09-2000 he left the College. Mr. Banadeep Kalita worked in the Department since 19-07-2007 to 06-02-2006. On 13-09-1993 Md. Ramjan Ali, present HOD, joined as a Lecturer in the Department of Political Science. Mr. Madan Mohan Brahma and Sri Nripen Das, the present Assistant Professors in the Department joined on 18-07-2001 and 01-08-2006. Still now Md Ramjan Ali (HOD), Madan Mohan Brahma and Sri Nripen Das have been serving in the Department of Political Science.

➤ **MEETING OF THE DEPARTMENT:-**

Since 2011-2012 with the introduction of Semester System and since 2019 with the introduction of CBCS the Departmental Meetings have been held before the commencement of the regular classes of the Semester. However the Department also conducts “SPECIAL MEETING “to discuss the progress of the students and any other related issues with the department. In the meeting the syllabus or courses (both for BA and HS) are discussed and distributed among the faculty members unanimously . The Routine of the department is also unanimously finalized and distributed .The Department keeps the records of all meeting in the respective Proceeding Books

➤ **TEACHING LEARNING METHOD:**

Generally the Department follows the Black Board method of teaching and learning. However, the Department frequently use other device like-departmental seminar; panel discussion, mock parliament, open house discussion etc to impart knowledge to the students. During 2021-23the Department two such programmes like one Mock Parliament and one Mock Gram Sabha. The students of both Honours and Regular are given Home Assignments. These activities other than the Class room are being performed by the Department .

➤ **MENTORING:**

Whats App Groups are opened for Honours and Regular Students to exchange subject related knowledge and remove any problems faced by them. They are personally kept in touch with the help of their phone numbers . They are often consulted in the Department during off time. They are encouraged both inside and outside the Class Room for bright and splendid future. The guardians are informed regarding the performance of their children. The needy students are provided necessary books from the Departmental Library.If necessary books are not available in the library; then the faculty members use to provide personal books.

➤ **EVALUATION:-**

Through regular tutorials; Home assignment; Sessional Examination; Group Discussion; the knowledge of the students are worked out. All the records are preserved and reviewed in the department.
