### Faculty as members in:-

I. <u>Editorials Boards</u>: All the members, sometimes or the other have remained members of editorial Board of the college magazine published yearly. Besides Dr. Shahidul Islam Jadid, worked as a member in research and publication cell & Sub-editor in the souveniour published on the occasion of Golden Jubilee, Balagaon High School, <u>Barpeta</u>.

### II. Meetings of the department:

Every year before the commencement of the new session the first meeting of the department has usually been organized. The meeting discusses about the distribution of syllabus and classes. Generally, two or three meetings are organized to discuss about question paper setting for sessional examination, departmental seminar, popular lecture programme etc. Besides, meetings are held to discuss about the activities to be undertaken by the Education Forum (Educatum) throughout the year as and when necessary.

### III. <u>Teaching learning method:</u>

The department not only follows the black board method but also organizes seminars, panel discussion, symposium, Excursions to make the students understood on some special issues. Sometimes ICT method has also used when necessary. Tutorial and remedial classes are other devices which are followed for the weaker students analyzing their progress report. Moreover, the department also maintains student feedback report. Revisions, analysis of probable questions are done in the class so that the students try to prepare the answer of the questions properly. Current topics related to the subject and the education system of the country concerned is often discussed in the class. Students are asked to prepare the Wall Magazine of the Education Forum on contemporary issues to make aware the students not only of education but also other interested students of the college.

### IV. <u>Evaluation:</u>

Through regular tutorials, Home Assignments and Unit Test, Sessional examinations, the knowledge and understanding of the concerned subjects by the students are evaluated. The results of the students are reviewed in the department.

- V. Revision, analysis of probable questions is done in the class so that the students try to prepare the answer of the questions properly.
- VI. Extra classes are often undertaken for the improvement of slow learners.
