The College took its birth with the generous donation of Rs.1000000/-(Ten Lakhs) only by a prominent citizen of Barpeta Road, Late Mohan Lal Choudhury, in the name of his elder brother Late Ganesh Lal Choudhury. As Such the institution bears the name "Ganesh Lal Choudhury College". The Classes of G.L. Choudhury College started from the academic year 1990-91, with two classes, that is Higher Secondary First Year and B.A. First Year Class.

The Department of History was also started from the academic session 1990-91, as a General (Core) subject in H.S.-I Year and B.A. Ist Year Classes. The Classes of First Year academic session were done by Professor Abdul Mannaf Sikdar of B.H.College Howly.
