#### **Department of Assamese: At a glance**

The pedestal of Ganesh Lal Choudhury College was founded and initiated with a healthy donation of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rs. Ten Lakh) Only by the Scholastic-minded Late Mohan Lal Choudhury in order to immortalise the name of his elder brother Late Ganesh Lal Choudhury and to spread the light of Higher Education through Barpeta Road town and its neighbouring areas. The foundation stone of the college was laid on 16<sup>th</sup> March, 1990 by the Honourable Ashok Kumar Saikia, the then Education Commissioner of Assam and it heralded a new name in the educational Scenario of Assam.

The classes for H.S. 1<sup>st</sup> Year (Arts) and B.A. 1<sup>st</sup> year were inaugurated in 1990 at the Barpeta Road Sahitya Sabha Bhawan The permission for the First year and Second year of Department of Assamese (MIL & El. Ass) was approved by Gauhati University on 24-04-1991 and 13-08-1994 respectively. The Department received its Govt. Concurrence for B.A. Part I on 03-04-1995. It got its TDC Part I Affiliation for the year 1994-95 on 04-01-1997. And T.D.C. Part II Affiliation on 24-10-1998. The Department of Assamese was honoured with Govt. Concurrence for T.D.C. Part II on 03-03-2000 and Permanent Affiliation for Degree classes on 31-08-2009.

Moreover, the permission for Major course of the Department for the Session 2003-04 was got from Gauhati University on 28-02-2003. Likewise, the Department got Govt concurrence for T.D.C. Part-I (Major course) on 06-12-2008. The permission for B.A 2nd year (Major) and Affiliation for TDC Part I was got on 30-04-2010. The Department got its Affiliation for TDC Part II (Major) on 28-07-2012.

#### **Appointment of Faculty Members:**

The Governing Body of G.L. Choudhury College started the various departments such as English, MIL (Ass, Hindi, Bangla), Political Science, Economics, Education, History, Elective Assamese & Philosophy at first. They appointed the lecturers for every department. The Governing Body decided to appoint **Sri Jagannath Barman** for the Dept. of Assamese. Then Sri Jagannath Barman joined in this department on 12-07-1990 and retired from his job on 31-03-2021. After his joining Sri Anima Devi joined as a lecturer on 12-10-1990. But Sri Anima Devi had to resign from her job on 16.06.1991 due to her personal problems. After the resignation of Sri Anima Devi, the Governing Body appointed Sri Pranita Devi, but there was no record found of her joining in the dept.

At that time, Sri Jagannath Barman was one man army in the dept. of Assamese. Then the Governing Body published an advertise at Newspaper for Seeking lecturer in the dept. of Assamese. An interview was held and the Governing Body Selected **Sri Rupamani Kakati** through the interview. Sri kakati joined in her job as lecturer on 23-08-1991 and she performs her duty till now. Moreover, Sri Krishna Das joined on 01-01-1994 as a lecturer and resigned from the job on 31-03-1994. Again, Sri Anjali Nath joined as a lecturer for one month only from 03-09-1994 to 02-10-1994.

Then the authority of the college thought about the shortage of teachers in the dept. of Assamese. So they published an advertise in Newspaper for Seeking lecturer in the dept. of Assamese. The interview Committee Selected Sri Biplob Deka. Mr. Deka joined as as a lecturer on 04-11-1994. At that time, large number of Students enrolled in the College. So, the Governing Body felt to appoint another teacher in the dept. of Assamese and then they published an advertise at Newspaper. An interview committee was formed. They were happy enough to Select **Sri Juthika Talukdar** as a lecturer through the interview. Sri Talukdar joined at the job as a lecturer on 01-08-2000 and she has been performing her duty till now.

It is notable that the Governing Body of the college decided to appoint Sri Jagannath Barman, the senior most teacher as the Principal-in-charge and he joined in his new job on the 25-11-2002. Then the authority of the College appointed Sri Rupamani Kakati as Head of the Department of Assamese Department. Before that Sri Biplob Deka resigned from the job on 30-09-2002 as he was selected as Assistant Professor in provincialised college. Then the Governing Body published an advertisement at Newspaper for seeking lecturer against the vacant post. Therefore, an interview committee was constituted and they selected **Sri Hemanta Kumar Das** through the interview. Sri

Hemanta Kumar Das joined as a lecturer at the dept. of Assamese on 18-08-2003 after resigning from the post of Lecturer, Dept. of Assamese, Manikpur Anchalik College, Bongaigaon. From that day, Sri Das has been performing his duty as a lecturer efficiently till today. Due to large enrollment of Students in the College as well as in Assamese dept, the Governing Body of the College decided to appoint another lecturer and thus they published an advertisement at Newspaper After the interview, the said Committee Selected **Sri Dipamani Medhi** who joined in her job on 23-09-2005 and from that day She has been working as a lecturer till date.

Sri Jagannath Barman, Principal-in-charge cum Assistant Professor of Assamese department got retired on 31-03-2021. The Governing Body published an advertisement against the vacant post of Sri Barman. An interview committee was constituted following the guidelines of Govt. Order. The interview committee Selected **Dr. Shikha Das** as Assistant Professor who joined in her job on 24-09-2023 and she has been doing her job till today.

#### **Year and Date of Provicialization:**

The college was provincialised by the Govt. of Assam on 01-01-2013 under the Assam Venture Educational Institution (Provincialisation of services) Act 2011, as amended in 2012.

#### **Meetings of the Department:**

Before the commencement of regular classes each year at least two departmental meetings are held among the faculty members and distributed the syllabus for both TDC & HS classes. Generally meetings are held in the month of August and January. Again departmental class routine is distributed among the members in the meeting. Moreover, the subjects of internal question paper setting, project, field study, results of exam etc. are discussed in the departmental meeting.

#### **Teaching learning Method:**

Generally the department follows the BLACK BOARD method of teaching & learning. The dept. of Assamese depends mainly on Chalk & Talk method. The syllabus of Assamese department consists of language, literature and culture. For the Syllabus of language the dept. uses Global & Google Map and for the Syllabus of Culture the faculty members display the Material culture. To impart knowledge to the students, the faculty members almost regularly try to set up Group Discussion & Home Assignment. Moreover, to develop literary talent of the students, the dept. of Assamese formed Assamese Literary Society in 2017 (Asomiya Sahitya Chora) and through this Society, a wall magazine namely 'Deep-Shika' is published every year.

#### **Award Recognitions to the Students by the Faculty:**

To encourage the Students having Assamese Major/ Honours the faculty members of the department decided to offer award to those who got first class in BA Final examinations. It was introduced for the first time in 2012-13 When Sri Ajanta Nath obtained first class. She received a packet of books as award. It is continued till date. #### **Library of the Department:**

We, the faculty members of Assamese dept. felt the need of a Departmental library. So, we decided to Set up a library with the help of authority of the college and then the authority provided a sum of Rs. 10, 000'00 (Rs. Ten Thousand) only to the Assamese dept. in 2016. Since then the dept. of Assamese has been providing one or two books to the economically poor students having Major / Honours in Assamese. There are numbers of 186 books in the library. Maximum no. of books are collected from the faculty. Former co-ordinator of IQAC Sri Sanjeeb Kr. Das donated 25 books then and we returned all the books to him after his retirement. Sri Juthika Talukdar, the HOD of the Assamese dept. has been assigned the responsibility for managing of the library since 2016.

#### **Attention to slow Learners:**

Most of the students enrolled into Assamese dept. are basically slow learners. The economic conditions of them are not so sound. The department pays Sincere attention to the weaker and economically poor students of the department. In this regard the department undertakes the following Steps -

- I. Issue at least two books for one semester to the weaker and poor students.
- II. The faculty members often communicate them out side the classrooms and try to Solve their academic problems.
- III. Provides hand-written notes, xerox copy etc. regularly.
- IV. The faculty members offer special classes for the weak students in each semester. However, no record in this regard is kept.


